



Jim Mebane Memorial Shoot **Saturday, 22 November 2008 - Fort Hood Skeet and Trap Club**



Format: 25 Skeet targets and 25 Wobble Trap targets. Registration begins at 8:30 a.m., and the last squad goes out at 2:30 p.m.

Price: \$15 for the event. Re-shoots are \$10 per Field; your highest score will count for Lewis Class only.

Prizes: Silver belt buckle for the overall winner. A flat of 12 ga. shells will be drawn for. Each entry gets one chance. Other prizes awarded by Lewis Class (**which means everybody has a chance to win, regardless of score**). There will be no more than 9 entrants in any Lewis Class. The number of classes will be based on participation. A hundred round box of shotgun shells will be awarded to the shooter with the top score in each class. A prize for the military high score will also be awarded. Any other prizes provided through corporate sponsorship will be awarded by methods to be determined by the sponsor and shoot management. All prizes will be awarded at 5:00 p.m. or as soon as possible after the shoot concludes. High score on the Wobble Trap followed by high score on the Skeet will break ties. If still tied, shoot off on Wobble Trap miss and out. **In Wobble Trap you may shoot twice at each target.**

Lunch: Lunch on your own.

Registration: There is no pre registration. Show up, sign up and shoot em up.

Liability: Spectators and contestants assume all risks of accidents or injury.

Post Access Policy: All contestants without vehicle stickers or passes must enter Fort Hood through the main gate. Weapons must be registered with the Fort Hood Provost Marshall before they can be used at the Skeet Range, however, guns will be available for use at the range.
