Shoot offs should begin around 3:00. No entries to an event are permitted after the above start times.

### FEES:

12GA	\$35
20GA & 28GA	\$17.50 EA
Doubles	\$17.50

### Concurrent Events:

All NSSA Concurrent Events are available.

There is "NO CHARGE" to enter the concurrent events, including HOA and HAA.

You must declare which concurrents you are eligible to compete in at registration.

### Trophies/Purses:

\$5 of 100 bird, and \$2.50 for 50 bird entries is returned as a purse to be split 50%/50% by the gun champion and one Lewis Class winner. All ties for gun CH/RU/3<sup>RD</sup> and concurrents will be shot off.

### RULES:

This shoot is registered by the NSSA and NSSA rules govern all events. Texas residents "must" have a current 2008 NSSA and TSSA

Membership Card. These are available at registration if necessary. Free membership in TSSA for new members. NSCA membership satisfies NSSA membership under Crossfire program.

### Shootoffs:

DOUBLES at stations 3, 4, & 5 under NSSA rules, with all tied events shot concurrently. Shootoff order will be HOA, Guns, and them concurrents. Concurrents may be shot off simultaneously with other Shootoffs. Any place that cannot be resolved by shoot offs or lack of daylight, will be long run IAW NSSA rules.

### Liability:

Spectators and contestants assume all risks of accidents and/or injury. Eye & ear protection is required on or near the skeet fields.

### Ammunition:

Hand loads will be permitted and NSSA rules will be observed.

"Proof" ammunition will be provided.

### Food:

Drinks and food are available for purchase at the Sportsmans Center.

### Directions to Club:

From Waco – IH35 to Kileen exit (US190); west on US190 until you reach the MAIN GATE at Fort Hood; continue straight until you dead end into RANGE Rd; turn left for ¼ mile to the Sportsman’s Center entrance; Skeet range is behind the Center.

From Austin – Take TX195 from IH35 thru Florence to US190; go west to MAIN GATE at Fort Hood; continue straight until you dead end into RANGE Rd; turn left for ¼ mile to the Sportsman’s Center entrance; Skeet range is behind the Center.

***All shotguns must be pre-registered at Ft. Hood before they can be brought on base. Day passes are available at the visitor’s center.***
